NOTE: FYI: Alcohol Sales Policies at Arvada Elks Club

The Arvada Elks Club, along with many other non-profit organizations, have come under recent State scrutiny for their liquor licenses. The Arvada Elks Club has a limited liquor license operating as a non-profit. The Fraternal Order of Elks charters their local clubs to operate as non-profit organizations. Therefore, the State of Colorado limits the Arvada Elks Club to sell alcoholic beverages only to its members and not to the public. For the immediate future, we plan to continue the Arvada Social Dance utilizing the Arvada Elks Lodge as our dance venue. While the new policies at the Elks Club will be an inconvenience to some of our dance customers, we hope it will not affect monthly attendance. We have every intention to continue providing quality dance entertainment in the Denver area. In accordance with the Elks Club, all dancers will be provided a full selection of non-alcoholic beverages/refreshment for sale from the bar. In addition the Elks Club will provide free non-alcoholic refreshments including water and iced tea. Alcoholic beverages/ refreshments may be purchased by Elks Club members only. Elks Club members will be allowed to purchase alcoholic beverages/refreshment for their guests.
